Time for a 12-Race Sunday at Gulfstream!

Gulfstream Park doesn't miss a beat this Sunday, with a 12-race card that begins a tad after noon ET. Sunday's dozen follows some serious Rainbow 6 mania on Saturday – we're talking a massive, buzzworthy Rainbow 6 payout; wonder if the entire pool eclipsed \$10 million? Well, no matter how things shook out for you Saturday, here's to a winning Sunday here in gorgeous Hallandale Beach, FL. Race 5 is one of Sunday's highlights as it features a number of well-connected 3yo fillies: Orra Moor, trained by Todd Pletcher, scored a sharp debut victory here right before Christmas. She recovered quickly off a slow start and drilled an easier field than the one she encounters Sunday. This filly by Orb, of course he won the Florida Derby and Kentucky Derby back in 2013, starts from post 6 with Hall of Fame jockey John Velazquez. Trainer Chad Brown, fresh off his third consecutive Eclipse Award as champion trainer, brings back Break Curfew with Hall of Famer Javier Castellano. This Into Mischief filly either disliked the slop and/or the 1 1/16 miles distance of the Golden Road at Churchill last out.

Brucia La Terra – I'm always rooting for veteran trainer Barclay Tagg and am anxious to see how his Grade 1-placed Brucia La Terra returns from the rail in race 5. This El Padrino filly surprised many at Saratoga with a 9-1 debut upset, which preceded a second – well beaten of course but still a major placing – behind 2yo Filly Champion Jaywalk in Belmont Park's Grade 1 Frizette. Obviously, her "DNF" in Aqueduct's Tempted back in November is a throw out.

Katieleigh – This Kathy Ritvo-trained Midnight Lute filly exits two strong races – against salty competition – in Southern California. It appears she's training forwardly for her first start in South Florida and first race since July 4th way out west at Los Al.
