GPW, Day 22 of 40: Forget the tricks. I'll take the good stuff: Reese's (120 Beyer), Kit Kats (115 Beyer) and, of course, a nice neat stack of Ben Franklins'. Here's hoping this Halloween Wednesday at Gulfstream Park West is a (very) profitable one for you. Week 6 of the GPW autumn racing season gets underway at about 1:20 p.m. ET. My personal favorite on the day is race 5, which is a wide-open 2yo filly maiden turf race. Indeed, the 5th is chockfull of unknowns and looks like a terrific wagering affair. Trainer Juan Arias did a very good job through the first half of this 40-day GPW meet. In fact, he entered Sunday's action in a tie for fifth in the standings with four victories. Wednesday, Arias will run first-time starting Moms Pride in the 5th race. This French-bred filly owns a stellar pedigree and world-class Juddmonte Farms lineage. As a self-aware pedigree nerd (and, at times, pedigree snob) I have to go on record that I absolutely love the female side of Moms Pride's pedigree. Tinge, her dam, is a half-sister to Grade 1 winners Empire Maker, Honest Lady, Chester House, Chiselling and Decarchy. There are many legendary Juddmonte families – the Hasili line-up with Heat Haze, Banks Hill, Intercontinental and Cacique comes to mind – but Tinge's family portrait is up there with the best. Of all time! As for Moms Pride, this filly has been training regularly at GPW and will get the services of top rider Emisael Jaramillo. Moms Pride, by Into Mischief, was bred and is owned by another powerhouse operation in the making, LNJ Foxwoods.

Looking for Halloween Hunch Plays: I was hoping to find at least a couple of Halloween appropriate names on Wednesday's GPW card. In the end, however, I came up with just one, **Candy Max**, a big-priced player in race 1. Speaking of the day's opener, here is a modest-sized early Pick 5 play for \$18. Because of the wide open and shaky-looking makeup of race 5, I am simply going to single my pedigree play, Moms Pride. She'll be right there if she has some talent. Best of luck!

R1: 4,8 -Candy Max would be perfect today, but War Pipe & Difference Maker look eons best
R2: 1,4,7 -Three very different, but logical-looking runners in race 2 on dirt
R3: 3,5,8 -Very difficult 2yo turf puzzle because of a lack of any real grass form
R4: 1,5 -Think Aunt Betty will like 2 turns; Awesome Clue is perfectly spotted
R5: 6 -Another 2yo turf crapshoot; absolutely love the pedigree of Moms Pride for LNJ
