



# RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

## RACE 1:

**1 SECRET O'LIFE** is stretching out to a mile after eventful local return in which she stumbled at the start, was shuffled back, then had to close 4-wide when finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> going 7 ½ furlongs last out.

**5 MI KARLITA** is an interesting choice in the opener after getting carried wide and still managing to finish an improved 2<sup>nd</sup> – at 84-1 – at this level and distance. **11 MIA'S BOBTAIL** is making her career turf debut after showing improved early interesting when stretching out to a 1-turn mile on the main track. Trainer Rohan Crichton tabs Tyler Gaffalione to handle the surface switch.

SELECTIONS: 1-5-11

## RACE 2:

**2 DISCREET HEAT** is wheeling back after responding in the first race after the claim by trainer Murat Sancal by using his speed to come within a nose of winning at this level and distance.

**1 ROYAL HOLIDAY** drops to the \$12,500 level with blinkers added after stalking the pace and 'hitting the board' in 1 of 2 recent outings at the \$30,000 level. Trainer Peter Walder has Tyler Gaffalione in the irons. **6 TAKEDOWN** moved to the Eddie Broome barn via the claim after tracking the pace and finishing  $3^{rd}$  – as the favorite – behind Discreet Heat last out.

**SELECTIONS: 2-1-6** 

## RACE 3:

**8 KEEPING THE PEACE** is a son of Elusive Quality debuting for trainer Jason Servis with Lasix, and 6 Palm Meadows workouts showing in preparation for the debut. Trainer Servis, 30% with his first-time starters, has Irad Ortiz Jr named to ride.

**2 HASTA LA BYEBYE** is making his 4-year-old debut at the \$50,000 level after showing promise vs maiden special weight sprinters here last summer. Trainer Joe Orseno has Roberto Alvarado Jr handling the first start in about 8 months.

**3 BULLGRATS** is making his local return for trainer Teri Pompay the first start since dueling for the lead and fading – as the favorite - when facing \$35,000 maidens at GP West. The barn, 5 for 13 (38%) with horses returning from a 61-180 days layoff, tabs Jonathan Gonzales to ride.

**SELECTIONS: 8-2-3** 

## RACE 4:

**6 JORDY'S READY** should be ready to make amends after responding in the first race after the claim by Marcus Vitali by pressing the pace and finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> – as the favorite – at this level and distance; Irad Ortiz Jr rides. **1 DANCING STARLET** will depart from the rail after responding to the stretchout from 7 to 8 furlongs with a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish at this level and distance. **2 SO FRESH** is hoping to find a little more firepower for the stretch drive after tracking the pace and finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> behind Jordy's Ready last out. Trainer Antonio Sano has Tyler Gaffalione handling the rematch.

**SELECTIONS: 6-1-2** 

## RACE 5:

**1 AVOCADO** is dropping to the \$50,000 level after the inconsistent 2-race turf campaign vs maiden special weight competition in which she was beaten less than a length when finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> on December 1<sup>st</sup>, and a track the pace and fade 10th when breaking from a tough post last out.

4 PEACEFUL FELLING, a daughter of War Front, is making her sophomore debut for trainer Chad Brown the first start since making a middle move and flattening out in her maiden special weight debut at Belmont last October. The barn, 31% with the 61-180 days layoff, has Tyler Gaffalione at the controls.

3 GET REWARDED is another dropping into the maiden claiming ranks after failing to fire when facing special weight competition going 5 furlongs here during December. Trainer Tom Bush has Javier Castellano handling the combo dropdown/stretchout.

**SELECTIONS: 1-4-3** 



## RACE 6:

**8 JOHNNY TICKETS** is dropping to the \$12,500 level on the main track after returning from the 4-month layoff to track solid early fractions before tiring to finish 5<sup>th</sup> vs \$25,000 claimers going 5 furlongs on the grass. Trainer Jason Servis is 38% with the turf-to-dirt angle. **4 ORGANIC JENNY** drops, and turns back to three-quarters of a mile, after 'hitting the board' in 1 of 2 recent outings going a mile vs \$20-25,000 claimers. Note both the ridglings previous victories where sprints. **6 BRAVER THEN WE ARE** is stepping up to face winners after responding to the class relief with a 'much the best' \$12,500 maiden victory.

**SELECTIONS: 8-4-6** 

#### RACE 7:

**3 INDICIA** is turning back to a mile after setting the pace and fading late when finishing 4<sup>th</sup> going a mile and a sixteenth. Trainer Armando De La Cerda has Roberto Alvarado Jr returning on the speedy daughter of Skipshot. **2 MS. MAXIMUM** is a daughter of Violence debuting on the turf for trainer Todd Pletcher after breaking poorly and failing to get untracked in a 'key' 6-furlong dash here on December 13, a race that produced a trio of next-out winners, including impressive repeat winner Queen of Beas. **4 CHARGE IT JENN** is turning back to a mile after rebounding from a disqualification 2 races back with a late-closing 3<sup>rd</sup> going a mile and a sixteenth last out.

**SELECTIONS: 3-2-4** 

## RACE 8:

**3 COME ON CITY (GER)** is making the 3<sup>rd</sup> start in North America after debuting locally and finishing a wide 3<sup>rd</sup> here at this level and distance. Trainer Graham Motion has Chris Landeros returning on the daughter of Wiener Walzer (Dynaformer).

**8 SO CHARMING** is turning back to 9 furlongs after returning from the layoff to finish a troubled 6<sup>th</sup> – beaten 3 lengths – in the mile & three-sixteenths \$75,000 Via Borghese. Trainer Michael Matz has the mare working consistently for this assignment.

**1 PASS IT ON** is stretching out to a mile and an eighth after returning from a 9-month layoff here in December and finishing a screw-tightening 6<sup>th</sup> going a mile and a sixteenth. Trainer Shug McGaughey has Javier Castellano atop the daughter of Data Link.

SELECTIONS: 3-8-1

#### RACE 9:

**6 ASTICOU TRAIL**, a daughter of Hard Spun, is making her 5-year-old debut for trainer Shug McGaughey the first start since following her maiden victory at Belmont with a 3<sup>rd</sup>-place finish vs 4 rivals in rained out turf allowance at Aqueduct. Note the back-to-back bullet workouts at Payson Park in preparation for the return.

**2 TREASURE IN HEAVEN** is stretching out to a mile after returning from the freshening to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> here vs entry-level allowance runners going 7 furlongs. Trainer Brian Lynch is 23% with the 2<sup>nd</sup> start after a 45-180 days layoff. **5 PRINCESS VICTORIA** is stretching out to 8 furlongs after responding in the first race after the claim by Jorge Navarro with a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish — as the 4-to-5 favorite — going 7 furlongs.

**SELECTIONS: 6-2-5** 

## **RACE 10:**

1 SECOND GUESS is dropping a notch, and getting Lasix, after breaking from the rail and failing to fire in his \$50,000 career debut. Trainer Brian Lynch has Javier Castellano in the irons. 5 COLD WARRIOR is dropping to the \$35,000 level after breaking from a demanding outside post (11), vying for the lead, and fading when facing state-bred maiden special weight competition here going 7 ½ furlongs. Trainer Scott Becker has Tyler Gaffalione named to ride.

**10 GO POKE THE BEAR** is dropping to this level, and adding blinkers, after failing to show much when facing maiden special weight competition on the Tampa turf. Trainer Todd Pletcher is 17% with first-time blinkers.

**SELECTIONS: 1-5-10** 

BEST BET: RACE 10 – 1 SECOND GUESS

**LONGSHOT: RACE 8 – 3 COME ON CITY**
