**Race 4:** I've been a big fan of trainer George Weaver for a number of years – watching his Saratoga County gobble up one big stakes win after another doesn't feel like all that long ago – and expect his first-time starting Competitive Saint to come out firing in Sunday's 4<sup>th</sup> race. First-race post time on this Sunday, May 3, is 12:45 ET. By Competitive Edge, Competitive Saint originally sold for \$90,000 as a yearling before his OBS March (2019) purchase price of \$160k; he worked a furlong of 10 seconds flat in that sale. He's also the sixth foal from the Royal Academy dam W W Old School, who notched her two on-track victories over the dirt. Competitive Saint has four winning older siblings. This is a very interesting maiden dirt sprint, a race dominated by first and second-time starters. Here's a little blurb on the competition, beginning with the 0-7 Sir Kahn.

**Sir Kahn** – exits the best last-out field won by recent Unbridled Stakes winner Dr Post. I like a shorter race for this Bayern colt (he cuts back from 7F to 6F) but would like to see him back up that last-out figure before I jump aboard.

**Harper** – In from Parx, this pricey Include colt exits a placing to the wire-to-wire winning Nothing Better on Mar. 10. He's the first horse to return from that field. Harper has speed and looks like a logical player for trainer John Servis.

**Getthe Munny Bernie** – This Munnings firster debuts at 4 for trainer Saffie Joseph Jr. and Paco Lopez. He's the fifth foal from an (0/2) dam; all four siblings are winners.

**Thrill Ride** – Ian Wilkes saddles this Candy Ride first-time starter, who is the fifth foal from the unraced Mr. Greeley dam, Heart Rate. This looks like more of turf pedigree to me considering Thrill Ride's dam has produced multiple turf winners in Pardon My Heart and Rate of Return, both based here in South Florida.
