



RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

RACE 1:

8 GOLOVKIN is going back to the turf after following a pair of promising races going a mile on the GP grass with a prompt-and-fade outing going 7 furlongs on a sealed sloppy track. Trainer Carlos David has Cristian Torres handling the surface switch. **9 STAND WITH MO**, a son of Uncle Mo, is debuting locally for trainer Christophe Clement, and turning back to 7 ½ furlongs, after stalking the action and fading in his 8 ½-furlong debut on the Belmont turf. The barn, 19% with maidens making their 2nd start, tab Edgard Zayas to ride. **1 KING UHTRED** is debuting locally for trainer Brendan Walsh, and breaking from the rail, after setting a pressured pace and yielding to finish 4th vs special weight foes going a mile on a 'good' Kentucky Downs turf. He's the inside speed with Angel Arroyo at the controls.

SELECTIONS: 8-9-1

RACE 2:

4 SPEARGUN is stepping up to face winners after drawing clear on a sealed sloppy track to defeat a pair of next-out winners in a \$32,000 maiden sprint contested at 5 ½ furlongs.

6 TIMEWON'TLETMEGO is another stepping up to face open-claimers after shifting into overdrive when defeating \$25,000 maidens going 6 ½ furlongs here last out. Trainer Kathleen O'Connell has Edgard Zayas named to ride. **5 KING TARZAN** is dropping into a competitive spot after following his \$25,000 maiden victory with a duel-and-fade performance vs \$50,000 starter optional claimers. Trainer Dave Braddy has Edgar Prado in the saddle.

SELECTIONS: 4-6-5

RACE 3:

5 AGOG, now in the Jon Arnett barn, the \$225,000 daughter of More Than Ready debuts locally after showing promise sprinting on the grass on the Kentucky circuit, which includes the recent 3rd place finish in the \$150,000 Indian Summer at Keeneland: Paco Lopez handles the first journey around 2-turns.

2 I GET IT is stretching out to a mile and a sixteenth after back-to-back victories going a mile, which includes the '2-lifetime' optional claiming score here last out. Trainer Ron Spatz has Edgard Zayas named to ride. **3 HAPPY CONSTITUTION**, bred to love the turf, the daughter of Constitution makes her first start since finishing 3rd – from a tough post (10) - in the rained-out Our Dear Peggy going 7 furlongs in the slop.

SELECTIONS: 5-2-3

RACE 4:

2 RABDAN is a son of Speightster debuting for trainer Gustavo Delgado with a sharp morning work tab showing over the local terrain: Joe Bravo rides. **6 TOSCANITO** has been burning up the GP West training track in preparation for the first race since having trouble at the start and never getting untracked behind future multiple stakes winner Breeze on By in his special weight debut during July. Trainer Antonio Sano has Paco Lopez handling the return to action. **5 MAXIM MOMENT** is a \$175,000 son of Hard Spun debuting for trainer Saffie Joseph Jr with 10 morning workouts showing in preparation for his first start. The freshman will have Edgard Zayas at the controls.

SELECTIONS: 2-6-5

RACE 5:

9 DONJI, who was claimed for \$12,500 during July, is dropping into this \$12,500 dated-claimer after 'hitting the board' in 3 of 4 races vs better before going to sidelines for some R & R during September. Trainer Bobby Dibona has Hector Berrios named to ride. **11 KEEP QUIET (FR)** is making his first start since rallying to come within a neck of winning at this level and distance – as the favorite – at GP during August. Trainer Saffie Joseph Jr is 24% with this type of layoff. **5 BASHA** will try 'non-winners of a race since May 28' competition after returning from Kentucky Downs and finishing a troubled 5th (stumbled start) vs \$10,000 open-claimers going 8 ½ furlongs here last out. Trainer Jena Antonucci has Angel Arroyo named to ride.

SELECTIONS: 9-11-5

RACE 6:

1 MADAME MOON is turning back to 7 furlongs after debuting locally and finishing a stalk-the-pace 4th vs this level of competition going a 2-turn mile. Trainer Victor Barboza Jr is 27% with the route-to-sprint angle. **4 CAPTURED LIGHT**, who finished 2nd in front of Madame Moon going 8 furlongs last out, will try to do the same at seven-eighths of a mile. Trainer Vaughn Heard has Luca Panici in the irons.

7 QUEEN LETIZIA, another from Victor Barboza Jr, will try to save more for the stretch drive after making a middle move and settling for 4th - at this level and distance last out. Angel Arroyo rides this half of the uncoupled entry.

SELECTIONS: 1-4-7

RACE 7:

4 ROBIN TEAM SHOW is dropping to the \$12,500 level, and returning to what appears to be his best surface (4-0-2-0) after a pair of clunkers here on the main track. Trainer Antonio Sano has Edgard Zayas atop this shaky proposition. **3 PRETENDANT**, a previous winner on the turf, is returning to the grass after finishing a rallying 2nd here in a race moved from the lawn to a mile and a sixteenth on the main track. Joe Bravo will handle the stretchout to a mile and an eighth. **1 YADI**, who was beaten a nose at this level on the GP turf during September, is going back to the grass, and stretching out to 9 furlongs, after rallying to finish 3rd and 2nd, respectively, in a local pair moved from the turf to sloppy main tracks.

SELECTIONS: 4-3-1

RACE 8:

6 ROCK WITH ROBIN, claimed for \$16,000 by Carlos David during August, drops to that level in the first start since setting the pace and weakening to finish 3rd vs \$32,000 stater allowance runners going 5 ½ furlongs at GP during September.

4 INCLUDE THE BEAST is stepping up, and stretching out, after drawing clear to win her \$16,000 career debut going 5 ½ furlongs here last out. Trainer David Fawkes is 21% winning consecutive races. **9 HOPE LADY** is dropping to this level after following her late-closing \$20,000 maiden victory across town with a stalk-and-retreat outing here vs \$32,000 starter allowance competition. Trainer Saffie Joseph Jr has Edgard Zayas handling the outside draw.

SELECTIONS: 6-4-9

RACE 9:

3 HONEY DONT is making his local turf return the first start since splitting a pair of next-out winners when finishing 2nd vs \$12,500 claimers going a mile on the Monmouth turf. Trainer Tim Hills has Joe Bravo named to ride. **11 PROJECTED (GB)** is turning back to a mile in the first start since chasing the pace and finishing 5th vs similar going 9 furlongs on the GP turf. Trainer Carlos David has Emisael Jaramillo atop the previous winner at the distance.

1 AMERICAN NINJA is making his local return after ending his turf campaign across town on a high note. The gelding followed his \$12,500 score in August with an even sharper victory vs \$20,000 claimers, both at this 1-mile distance. Trainer Jose Gallegos has Marcos Meneses going for the hat trick.

6 MACAGONE is debuting locally for Kelly Breen after the somewhat consistent turf campaign vs similar quality at Monmouth. Edgard Zayas will ride the 11-time turf winner.

SELECTIONS: 3-11-1-6

RACE 10:

7 KARAMOJO is dropping to the \$16,000 level after returning from the 4-month layoff to finish a late-closing 4th vs \$20,000 maidens going 7 ½ furlongs on a 'good' turf. Trainer Kelsey Danner has Angel Arroyo named to ride. **3 CALL BROS** is another dropping to this level after returning from a 2-month freshening to duel for the lead and finish 3rd in front of Karamojo last out. Trainer Joe Orseno has Paco Lopez trying to get the barn off the duck.

1 ON DUTY is dropping to this level after making a middle move and fading vs \$40,000 maidens going a mile and a sixteenth on the Belmont turf. Trainer Tim Hills has Joe Bravo handling the class relief.

SELECTIONS: 7-3-1

BEST BET: RACE 3 – 5 AGOG

LONGSHOT: RACE 9 – 3 HONEY DON'T
