



RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

RACE 1:

9 SUM NATION moved to the Saffie Joseph Jr barn via the claim, and drops to the \$25,000 level, after recovering from a slow start to finish a late-closing 4th in her \$40,000 career debut for trainer Todd Pletcher: Edgard Zayas rides this shaky dropdown.

1 SERENADE A KITTEN will be outfitted with blinkers after racing greenly in her \$25,000 career debut going 7 ½ furlongs on the GP West turf. Trainer Mike Maker has Miguel Vazquez handling the daughter of Kitten's Joy.

2 CHEERLEADER BARB is stretching out slightly after recovering from a slow start to finish 3rd in her \$25,000 career debut going 7 ½ furlongs across town. Trainer Kathleen O'Connell tabs Emisael Jaramillo to ride.

SELECTIONS: 9-1-2

RACE 2:

4 MUSTANG CAT became the only participant in the race to win at this 7-furlong distance when he used his speed to defeat \$6,250 claimers going 7 furlongs on a wet-fast surface across town. Trainer Peter Walder is 21% winning consecutive races.

6 RESIDENT, another from trainer Peter Walder, is dropping to the \$12,500 level after following his \$8,000 dated-claiming victory with a troubled starting (stumbled badly) 7th place finish vs \$16,000 state-bred optional claimers going a 2-turn mile at GP West: Luis Saez rides. **5 SOUTH SEA** is dropping to the \$12,500 level, and stretching out to seven-eighths of a mile, after facing considerably tougher locally with limited success. Trainer Bobby Dibona has Hector Berrios trying to reignite the gelding's back class.

SELECTIONS: 4-6-5

RACE 3:

5 SHAKEM is eligible to take another positive step forward after responding to the re-addition of blinkers with an improved 2nd place finish going a mile on the GP West turf. Trainer Bobby Dibona has Hector Berrios named to ride.

8 JULIE BIRD (IRE) is dropping to the \$25,000 level after moving into the Mike Maker barn and finishing a stalk-and-fade 7th – as the favorite – vs \$40,000 maidens going a mile on the GP West turf: Joe Bravo rides. **10 LA PINTA** will break towards the outside after finishing a workman-like 5th in her \$25,000 career debut going 7 ½ furlong on a 'good' GP West turf. Trainer Jane Cibelli has Paco Lopez in the irons.

SELECTIONS: 5-8-10

RACE 4:

7 HARTLING moves to the Saffie Joseph Jr barn, and plunges to the \$6,250 level, after facing tougher here during the summer with limited success. The barn, 30% with new additions to the shedrow, name Edgard Zayas to ride. **1 INEDATEQUILA** is making her local return after dominating the competition across town when she reeled off 3 consecutive victories going around 2-turns. Trainer Kent Swezey has Paco Lopez handling the inside post. **3 GRACE'S DRAMA**, a specialist going a 1-turn mile locally, returns after failing to fire when trying similar quality going a mile & 70 yards across town. The 9-time local winner, and the 8-time winner at the distance, will have Hector Berrios trying to spring the upset.

SELECTIONS: 4-1-3

RACE 5:

1 QUEEN ABARRIO, whose only previous outing sprinting on the grass was a 2nd-place finish – beaten a neck – at this level and distance here during April, returns after finishing a screw-tightening 4th on the GP West main track. Trainer Carlos Perez has Edgard Zayas named to ride. **6 LA CARA BONITA** moved to the Victor Barboza Jr barn via the claim, and returns from the layoff, after threatening to win at this level here before going to sidelines during June. The new connections add blinkers, and add Luis Saez, who rode her to victory here in January. **8 EFFIEMEISTER** is dropping a notch after failing to get untracked when facing \$25,000 maidens going 5 furlongs on the GP West turf. Trainer David Fawkes has Emisael Jaramillo trying to spark a wakeup call.

SELECTIONS: 1-6-8

RACE 6:

1 WEST WILL POWER is debuting locally for trainer Kelly Breen after going undefeated in his 2 races at Monmouth, including his last when he received a 95 Beyer figure for his effort. Joe Bravo is going for the hat trick. **4 MEXICAN WONDER BOY** moved to the Danny Gargan barn via the claim, and is shortening up to a 1-turn mile, after just getting nailed at the wire when beaten a head vs \$40,000 claimers going 8 ½ furlongs on the Keeneland main track. The barn, a whopping 46% with new claims, has Luca Panici named to ride. **6 EVERFAST** is back in the allowance ranks after failing to hit the board in a trio of stakes races. Trainer Jack Sisterson has Luis Saez named on the 2019 Grade 1 Preakness Stakes 2nd place finisher.

SELECTIONS: 1-4-6**RACE 7:**

4 I AM THE GREY is a son of Mizzen Mast debuting for trainer Jorge Delgado in a perfect spot for a first-time starter to succeed. The freshman starts his campaign with Luis Saez named to ride.

8 TURLOUGH is a beautifully bred son of English Channel debuting for trainer Todd Pletcher with a string of workouts showing, both turf and dirt, in preparation for only the \$25,000 career debut: The barn, 15% with their debut turf runners, have Paco Lopez named to ride. **3 UNCLE FUN** is dropping to the \$25,000 level, and adding blinkers, after 'hitting the board' in 1 of 2 recent turf outings at the \$40,000 level: Edgard Zayas rides.

SELECTIONS: 4-8-3**RACE 8:**

4 SWAGGY GEORGE, who has the distinction of being the only multiple winner in the field (5-2-1-0), moved to the Sandra Matier barn via the claim after finishing 2nd vs \$25,000 claimers going 6 furlongs across town. The new connections keep the status quo with Edgard Zayas at the controls.

3 ONEMORETIMEAROUND is dropping to the \$25,000 level after following his debut victory at the \$50,000 level with a poor showing in the \$60,000 Juvenile Sprint. Trainer Mike Maker has Luis Saez handling the dropdown.

6 TOP BOSS moved to the Julio Cartagena barn via the claim after finishing a troubled 3rd (hit rail) behind Swaggy George as the 3-to-5 favorite.

SELECTIONS: 4-3-6**RACE 9:**

1 AWSUM ROAR, now in the Antonio Sano barn, the 6-time local turf winner returns, and drops to the \$16,000 level, after facing allowance company up north with limited results. The 8-time winner at the distance will have Edgard Zayas handling the homecoming. **3 SUBSIDIARY** is stepping up to face open-competition after the pair of solid sprint efforts across town, including the \$12,500 '3-lifetime' score last out. Trainer Mark Casse has Luca Panici going for 2 in a row. **5 MISS MIAMI** is stepping up the competition after responding to the dropdown in competition with a rousing \$10,000 claiming victory going 5 panels on the GP West turf. Trainer Ed Plesa Jr has Paco Lopez in the saddle.

SELECTIONS: 1-3-5**RACE 10:**

2 ALL GOOD, whose only previous turf race was a 2nd-place finish vs allowance company at Golden Gate Fields, moves to the Mike Maker barn after finishing 3rd vs this level of competition going a mile and a sixteenth on the Churchill main track.

3 THENORTHREMEMBERS is debuting locally for trainer Dom Schettino after finishing a track the pace 5th on a soft Belmont turf. The 4-year-old, who broke his maiden on this course, will have Paco Lopez at the helm. **5 MAVERICK KITTEN** moved to the Eddie Broom barn via the claim, and makes his first start since finishing a rallying 3rd vs similar going 9 furlongs here in September. The new connections tab Hall of Fame jock Edgar Prado to ride.

SELECTIONS: 2-3-5**BEST BET: RACE 9 – 1 AWSUM ROAR****LONGSHOT: RACE 5 – 1 QUEEN ABARRIO**
